

Post-Doc / REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Possible duration: 6 months

- Copy of valid passport (in case the applicant does not have a valid passport, a copy of another id can be uploaded)
- CV
- Motivation letter*(= cover letter, document written by the applicant explaining the reason why he/she applies)
- Work Plan* for the mobility period showing which activities the applicant will conduct at the host university. The signature and approval of the host institution contact person (corresponding to the offer) is compulsory: the applicant must contact him/her as early as possible.
- Recommendation letter (to be uploaded with the other documents, if not possible, can be sent to heritage@ec-nantes.fr)
- PhD degree certificate. For applicants who are in the final year of their PhD degree at the moment of the application, a document certifying the expected completion date signed by their home institution must be provided.
- Official language certificate corresponding to the requirements of the courses chosen by the applicant. (In case the applicant did not pass any language test, a certificate from a professor from the host institution certifying the language level can be uploaded).
- If you declared being in a vulnerable situation, you must add a document proving it.
- If you are currently a PhD student, provide a document certifying that you are registered in an indian HEI.

All documents must be in English, if not, please provide a translated certified copy in English.

**These documents must be prepared and uploaded for each offer chosen.*
